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Illumination Fund

The Illumination Fund offers small grants, up to \$500, to support student-led projects that arise from the implementation of Project Heart.

Amount We Fund

There are four types of Illumination Funds:

- <u>Materials grant</u>: a grant up to \$500 to purchase supplies for a service project. (Ex: cleanup day, luncheon fundraiser, lemonade stand, etc.)
- <u>Matching grant</u>: The OtterCares Foundation will match up to \$500 raised by a student-led fundraiser to benefit a 501c3 nonprofit organization.
- <u>Collection drive match</u>: The OtterCares Foundation will make a donation to the nonprofit your project benefits based on the number of items you collect.
- <u>Field trip fund:</u> The OtterCares Foundation will reimburse the cost of transportation for a field trip to a local nonprofit organization. NOTE: Field trip requests will only be considered if there is a corresponding service project with the same nonprofit organization.

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How to Apply

- Step 1: Integrate Project Heart materials into instruction with K-12 students
- Step 2: Fill out and submit the Educator Application.
- Step 3: Once released, form a grant writing team to work on the Student Application
- Step 4: Students submit Student application.
 - For younger students, instructors may copy their answers from the template into the online form.

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Illumination Fund FAQ

When do we fund?

Applications are accepted on an ongoing basis so you can apply anytime!

Who can apply?

Any 501c3 nonprofit organization or school that is actively using Project Heart can apply for the Illumination Fund.

How many Project Heart lessons do I need to implement?

One of the really great things about Project Heart is the flexibility in which you present the material to your students. There is no expectation of a minimum or maximum number of lessons that you should present in order to apply for the Illumination Fund.

How many Illumination Fund applications can I submit in one school year?

Each classroom can receive up to two Illumination Fund grants per year. Please note that if you apply for a field trip reimbursement, there must be a corresponding service project with the same nonprofit.

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Can I submit two applications for the same project?

Yes - you are welcome to apply for two Illumination Fund applications for the same project when it makes sense.

What if my students are too young to complete the application themselves?

We suggest guiding younger students through the application conversationstyle. Read each question aloud, help them formulate their answers, and record what they'd like to say on the student application for them.

What if my class has more than two projects?

We ask that you determine which two projects from your class would benefit the most from our Illumination Fund.

What if my request is over the \$500 threshold?

Anything that is over the \$500 threshold we ask that you work with your school to cover the remaining amount.
